About the course: The Sphere Project – or 'Sphere' – was initiated in 1997 by a group of humanitarian non-governmental organisations (NGOs) and the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement. Their aim was to improve the quality of their actions during disaster response and to be held accountable for them. They based Sphere's philosophy on two core beliefs: first, that those affected by disaster or conflict have a right to life with dignity and, therefore, a right to assistance; and second, that all possible steps should be taken to alleviate human suffering arising out of disaster or conflict. Striving to support these two core beliefs, the Sphere Project framed a Humanitarian Charter and identified a set of minimum standards in key life-saving sectors which are now reflected in the Handbook's four technical chapters: water supply, sanitation and hygiene promotion; food security and nutrition; shelter, settlement and non-food items; and health action. The Core Standards are process standards and apply to all technical chapters.

This course will prepare you to apply the Sphere standards to your work in disaster settings. It aims to be an effective training as a means to ensure you are equipped with the skills and knowledge you require to deliver successful humanitarian aid programmes.

Who should attend? The course is aimed at individuals from humanitarian and development agencies in disaster response, prevention, mitigation and/or preparedness or those generally interested in such activities.

Registration will take place from 8.45 am.

Training will begin at 9.00 am and finish at 6.00 pm.

Participants will be actively encouraged to engage in classroom discussions, group work and a simulation or case study. The trainers will draw on both theoretical and practical knowledge in order to make the experience and learning applicable to the realities of field logistics in a humanitarian disaster. The fees are inclusive of all refreshments.
